


Funding Framework – Overview





UN-Women Contributions, 2011-2021


*old revenue recognition policy






UN-Women Contributions, 2011-2021 (in US\$ million)


Regular Resources Revenue as a Proportion of Total Voluntary Contributions



Despite overall growth in RR, the actual share of RR has steadily declined from 55% in 2011 to 30.2% in 2021 (below the 41% target in the Integrated Budget)




Contributions by Funding Channel, 2020 – 2021
