

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS IN 2023

Most significant gains

- DCO exceeded the requirements for six indicators and met the requirements for another eight indicators.
- Significantly in 2023, DCO newly exceeded the requirements for the Capacity Development indicator.

Areas for improvement

 UN Women encourages DCO to focus on the two indicators currently rated as approaching requirements: Financial Resource Allocation and Capacity Assessment.




COMPARISON OF OVERALL PERFORMANCE WITHIN THE UN SYSTEM, 2019-2023

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In 2019, the UN Secretariat entities and the overall UN System outperformed DCO on average. In 2023, DCO outperformed the averages of all others in the comparison.





In 2023, DCO met the requirements for more indicators than the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System on average. The entity did not miss the requirements for any indicators.

COMPARISON OF RATINGS BY YEAR, ENTITY SPECIFIC, 2019-2023



From 2019 to 2023, DCO sustained solid progress by meeting and exceeding the requirements for significantly greater proportion of indicators.

In 2023, the entity slightly trailed its 2022 performance by meeting one fewer indicator.
