

Most significant gains


- OCHA exceeded three indicators: Financial Resource Tracking, Gender Architecture and Knowledge and Communication.
- In 2023, OCHA achieved notable progress by newly "meeting" three indicators: Results Reporting, Leadership and Equal Representation of Women.

Areas for improvement

- UN Women encourages OCHA to focus on the three indicators approaching requirements: Strategic Planning, Financial Resource Allocation and Capacity Assessment.
- Increased focus is needed to reclaim previous achievement for the Audit and Policy indicators that regressed in rating in 2023.

PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In both 2018 and 2023, OCHA maintained a strong performance that was above the averages of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System.
