

Areas for improvement



PERCENTAGE OF RATINGS MEETING/EXCEEDING REQUIREMENTS (NOT APPLICABLE RATINGS OMITTED)




In 2018, the performance of UNOV/UNODC was below the average of the UN Secretariat and the overall UN System. In 2023, UNOV/UNODC achieved the highest share of meeting and exceeding ratings in the comparison.

In 2023, UNOV/UNODC exceeded more than twice as many indicators compared to both the UN Secretariat as a whole and the overall UN System.
