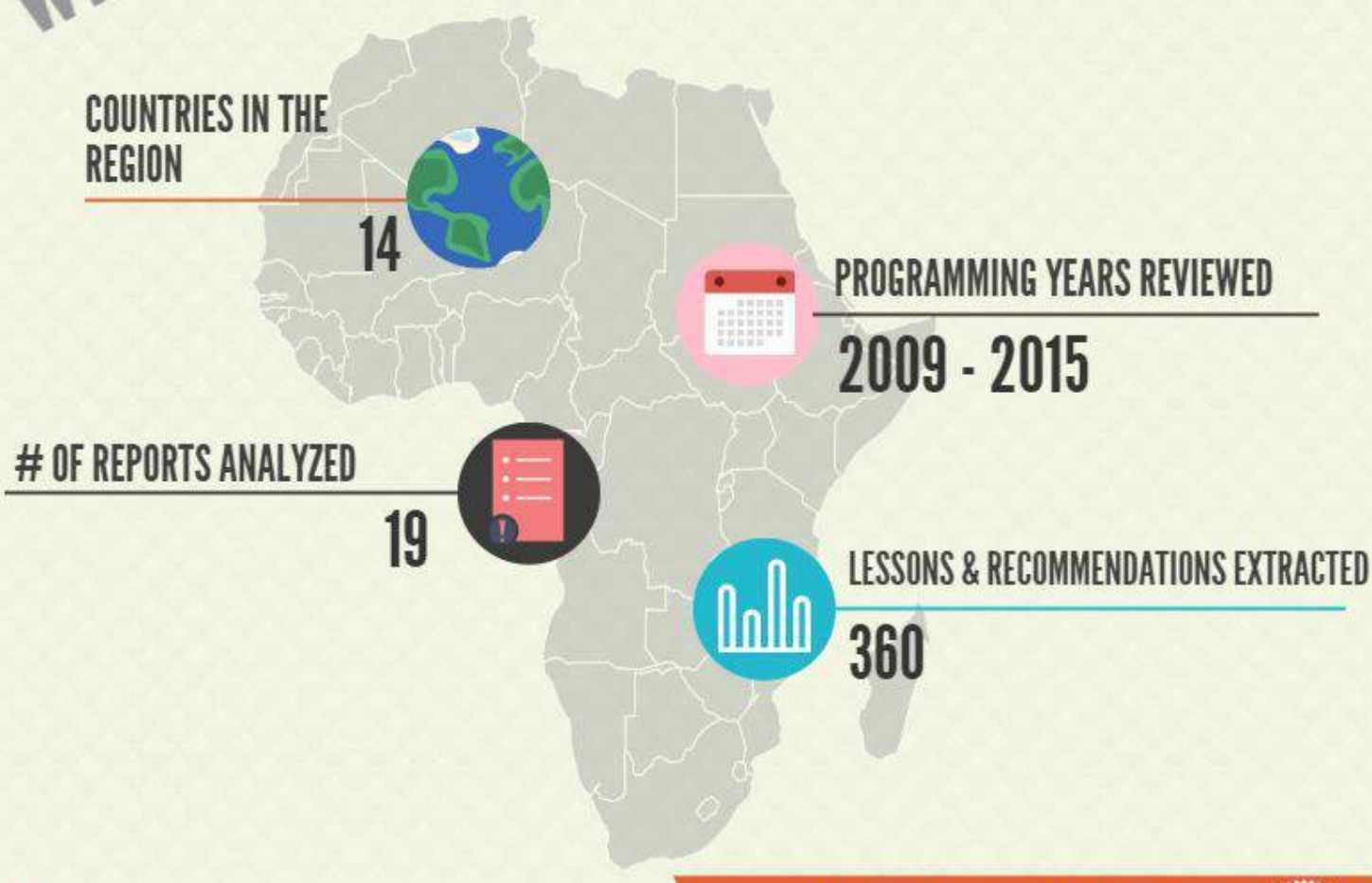

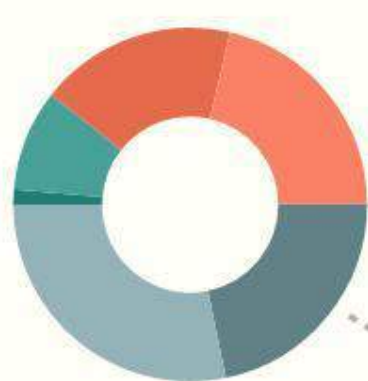

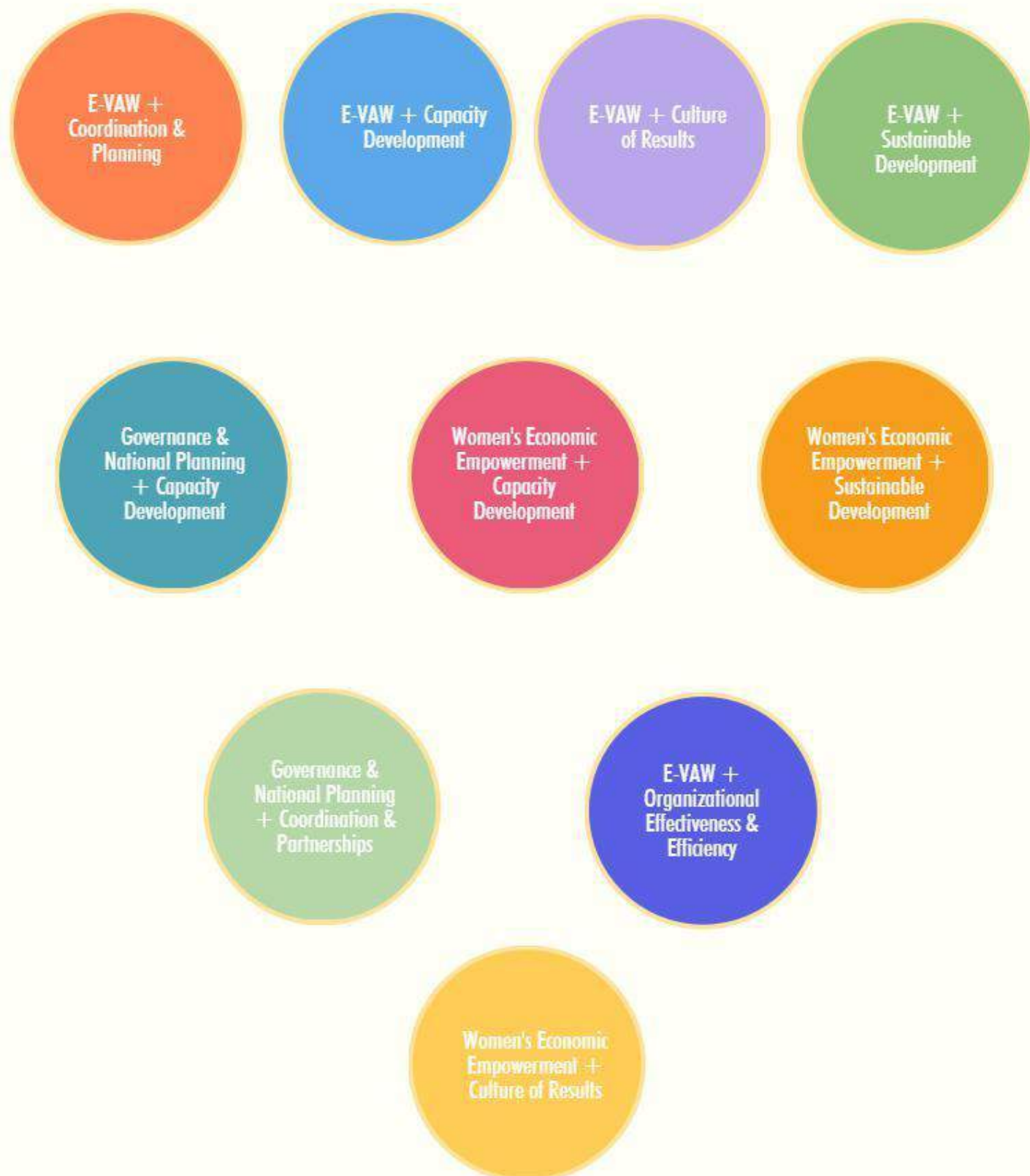
TOP INFORMATION
