





Women and girls contribute to and have greater influence in building sustainable peace and resilience and benefit equally from the prevention of natural disasters and conflicts and from humanitarian action












IBC on Gender Equality


- √ The IBC-Gender Equality is a strategic entry point to foster greater coherence

- ✓ Co-chaired: UNFPA and UN Women
- ✓ Members: FAO, ILO, OHCHR, UNDP, UNECE, UN Environment, UNESCO, UNFPA, UNICEF, UN Women, WFP, WHO

II. MAPS: gender equality as SDGs accelerator






III. Guidance on gender accountability tools:

- ✓ Gender Scorecard,
- ✓ Gender mainstreaming into UNDAFs,
- ✓ Gender analyses,
- ✓ Gender audit,
- ✓ Application of the new guidelines on UNDAF or operation of the UNCT GTGs.

IV. Regional policy level advocacy:

- ✓ Monitoring trends: Regional Advocacy Brief
- ✓ Inter-governmental processes (Regional Forum on Sustainable Development, CSW, regional conferences, ICPD Review)
- ✓ Treaty Bodies and Women's rights: Istanbul Convention, CEDAW, partnership with COE, GREVIO, regional actors, extended IBC meeting





Common Chapter

- **✓ Gender equality** one of priorities for Common Chapter implementation
- ✓ Initial mapping reveals:
 - 34 joint programmes with at least two or more of the CC agencies
 - 13 countries joint resource mobilization
 - 7 countries joint advocacy work
- ✓ Implementation on 2 levels:
 - ✓ Regional
 - **✓** Country level:
 - √ Turkey: JP on child marriage
 - ✓ Moldova: strengthening national statistical; systems
 - ✓ Ukraine: research on IMAGES
 - √ Georgia: JP on Gender equality
 - **✓ BIH:** JP on Support to SGBV survivors

✓ Next Steps:

- **✓** Joint communication to COs
- ✓ More detailed mapping on three priority areas
- ✓ Strengthen regional- county level engagement, technical support and guidance, inducing from IBC
