

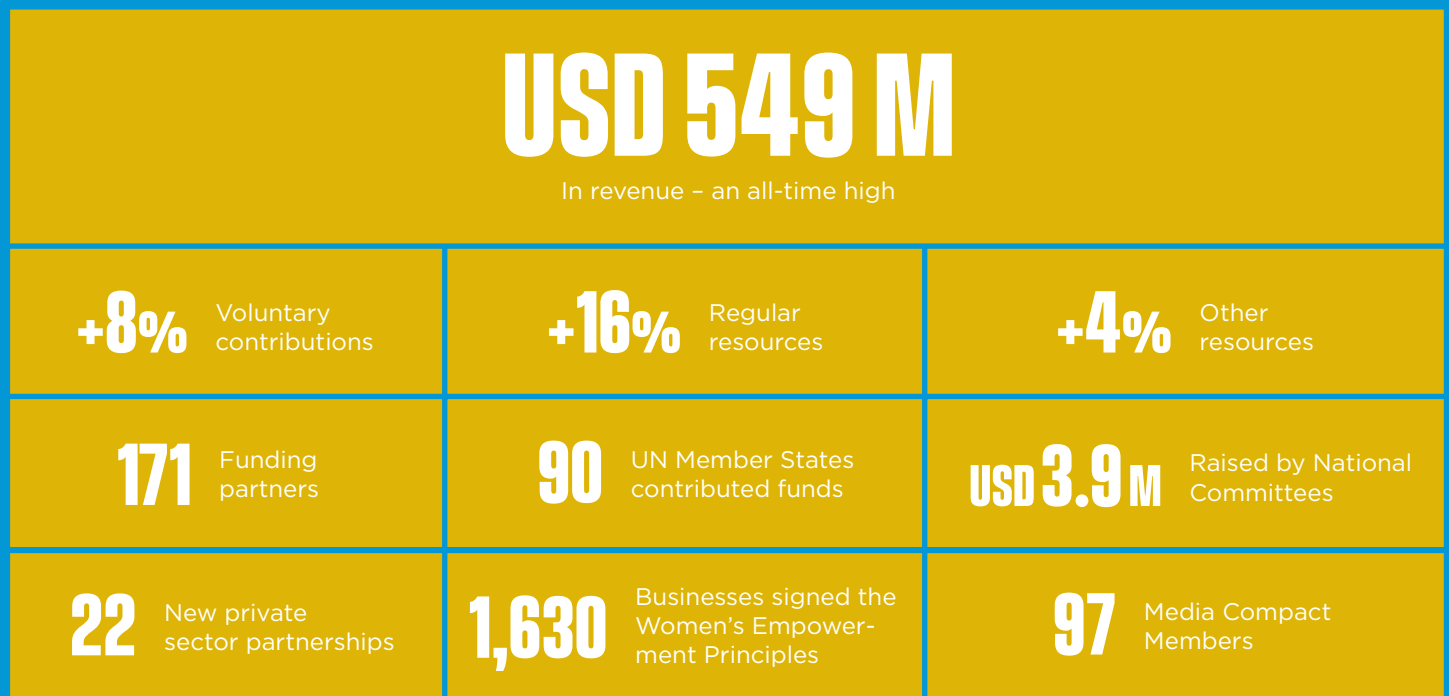


OUR PARTNERS MAKE THE DIFFERENCE

Last year, despite the competing priorities on resources resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, UN Women's funding partners provided steadfast and increased support, enabling the organization to continue empowering and protecting millions of women and girls, including providing support to immediate and long-term aspects of the global COVID-19 response and recovery.

For the second consecutive year, UN Women's total revenue exceeded USD 500 million. Voluntary contributions from 91 governments and intergovernmental organizations, 25 inter-organizational arrangements and international financial institutions, and 55 private sector and other partners accounted for 96 per cent of the USD 539 million in total revenues. The remaining 4 per cent constituted assessed resources and other revenue from investment income, exchange transactions and other sources.

Regular resources, which provide the institutional financial backbone for UN Women to carry out its triple mandate, grew by 16 per cent, to USD 166 million. It is these flexible resources that enabled the organization to adapt quickly and effectively in response to the pandemic.



Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, Sweden and the United States generously increased their regular resources contributions. The European Commission, Finland, the Multi-Partner Trust Fund Office, Norway and Sweden were our top five funding sources. Among the top private sector contributors were the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation and the BHP Billiton Foundation.

We appreciate all of our partners for the extraordinary support in 2020, and look forward to our continued collaboration in amplifying the call for gender equality and women's empowerment.

NOTES:

These statements have been prepared on an accrual basis, in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS). Under the accrual basis of accounting, revenues and expenses are recognized in the financial statements in the period to which they relate.

Assessed contributions are issued as an annual allotment from the United Nations regular budget, and are assessed and approved for a two-year budget period. The amount of these contributions is then apportioned between the two years.
