### Regional architecture

The Executive Board, in paragraph 7 of its decision 2012/4 requested the Under-Secretary-General/Executive Director of UN-Women to submit a report on the overall administrative, functional and budgetary implications of the regional architecture, including an implementation plan, with the view to taking a final decision at its second regular session of 2012. The report (UNW/2012/10) was prepared in consultation with the Board, following the initial presentation of the regional architecture to the Board at its annual session of 2012 (UNW/2012/5).

# Item 4 Financial, administrative and budgetary matters

In paragraph 12 of its decision 2011/5, the Executive Board requested the Under-Secretary-General/Executive Director to submit, for the consideration of the Board, proposals for the principles, criteria and procedures that should guide the use of cost-recovery income, taking into account the harmonized cost-recovery policies and methodologies used by the United Nations Children's Fund, the United Nations Development Programme and the United Nations Population Fund. The report (UNW/2012/13) presents an update on the progress made by UN-Women and those United Nations funds and programmes towards achieving a harmonized cost-recovery policy.

In accordance with financial regulation 19.2 (a), UN-Women will propose to the Executive Board an approach for calculation of an operational reserve. The Board may wish to review and approve the proposed methodology for calculation of the operational reserve and the establishment of a reserve for field office accommodation (UNW/2012/14).
